The St Antony's International Review (STAIR) is recruiting Theme Section Editors for its May 2018 issue. We are keen to receive suggestions of potential themes from Oxford graduate students in a variety of disciplines and from all colleges. Proposals should stimulate debate, and demonstrate potential article topics. Themes will be voted on by the STAIR members, and those who propose the winning theme will become the Theme Section Editors and STAIR board members.

STAIR is the University of Oxford's only peer-reviewed graduate journal of international affairs. Founded by graduate students of St Antony's College in 2005, STAIR has carved out a distinctive niche as a cross-disciplinary outlet for research on the most pressing contemporary global issues, providing a forum in which emerging scholars can publish their work alongside established academics and policymakers. Distinguished past contributors include John Baylis, Alexander Betts, Charlotte Hess, Robert Keohane, Richard Ned Lebow, and Sarah Percy. Each issue contains a Theme Section and a General Section.

Major criteria for selection of a STAIR theme are:

- ❖ International focus on matters of contemporary relevance
- ❖ Potential for cross-disciplinary dialogue and high-quality contributions

Your role as Theme Section Editor will be to:

- ❖ Write, edit, and circulate the call for papers and headhunt academics to contribute
- ❖ Select articles for peer review
- ❖ Find peer reviewers and send anonymous articles for peer review
- ❖ Compile peer reviews, select articles to publish, and edit articles/coordinate with authors to prepare articles for publication
- ❖ Be an active member of the STAIR Editorial Board throughout your involvement
- ❖ Find and interview a prominent figure related to the theme for the feature interview

What you need to do to apply:

- (1)** Form a team of 2-3 highly motivated students and come up with a theme for the issue.
- (2)** Submit a 1-page pitch on why this theme is important, stating possible article topics and contributors, to leah.matchett@trinity.ox.ac.uk by **Friday 13th October (Week 1), 23:59**. For a sample pitch, email leah.matchett@trinity.ox.ac.uk
- (3)** Come to the elections on **Monday 16th October (Week 2) at 19:30** in the Dahrendorf Room, St Antony's College. Please prepare a 5-minute speech to present your proposal.

STAIR meets at 19:30 every Monday evening during term in the Dahrendorf Room at St Antony's.
